Clarification on repair and maintenance of roads constructed on forest lands for public purpose prior to 1980.

I am directed to refer to your letter No.F.1(17) Van/91 dated 20-7-2004 on the above mentioned subject. In this regard, the matter has been examined by the Central Government in its entirety. Since, good roads are the means of better communication and indicator of development and as these also help in better patrolling, protection and management of forests, the Central Government issue the following electifications for the repair and maintenance of roads constructed on forest lands for public purpose prior to commencement of Forest (Conservation) Act, 1980:

Coads constructed on forest lands prior to 25.10.1980 (date of enactions of FC Act, 1986) how be repaired and maintained and black topping may be done with prior permission of the Forest Department, While undertaking such works, State Government shall ensure: .

No uce felling should be allowed.

No widening of roads should be undertaken without prior permission of the Consti-Government under Forest (Conservation) Act, 1980.

No breaking of fresh forest land is carried out. .

While bleck-topping, adequate precaution should be taken by the user agency to available (iii) any damage to flora and flama.

Plantation activities are taken up along the road at the cost of user agency, if i'm (V)concerned Divisional Forest Officer finds it necessary.

However, for the repair and maintenance of roads in protected areas like National Park/Sanctuaries, prior permission of National Board of Wildlife shall be taken by the State Government on case to case their in view of the Supreme Court order dated: 14-2-2000 in Writ Petition (C) No. 202 of 1995.

This issues with the approval of competent authority.
